

HSV TOWNHOUSE ASSOCIATION WEED CONTROL/FERTILIZATION, TRIMMING, WATERING



The first application of weed control begins before ground temperatures reach 55 degrees F, typically during the months of January or February, and weather conditions permitting. The first application of fertilizer will be made in March or April and may be either granular or liquid, also depending on weather conditions. Allow 7 to 10 days for results. All courts are re-quired to have weed control, but not all have fertilization. Fertilizing in a court is at the court's request, and funds available in the court. Subsequent mid-year fertilizer applications will be a controlled-release type and may be applied with weed control as needed. Late year application of fertilizer and weed control will be applied during the period from September through December.



Crape Myrtles are trimmed in February.



Azaleas are trimmed after flowering.



Watering begins in mid-April depending on spring rains and weather conditions.



Shrubbery is trimmed in all courts in April, July, and September, as needed for appearance, allowing for flowering and berrying.
